

## Changes to Blue Card Application Forms



### Commission for Children and Young People and Child Guardian

From 31st May 2006 there have been some changes to the documentation required by the commission to verify a person's identification when applying for a blue card. Blue card application forms have been amended accordingly and new forms are now available from the application forms page of this website. However the commission will continue to accept the old forms until 30 November 2006

Where possible, we now encourage people applying for a blue card to attach a copy of their proof of identification documentation to their application. This will enable the commission to check any information on the application form on which we are unclear, and where information has not been provided on the application form we may be able to locate the relevant information from the copies of the identification documentation rather than send a request to the applicant for further information.

The following proof of identification documentation is now accepted.

#### List 1

- \* Current driver license/learner's permit / proof of age card (with photo) - Australian or international
- \*Current passport (with photo) - Australian or International

#### List 2

- \*Current blue card
- \*Current student card (with photo and signature)
- \*Current QLD Gaming machine license
- \*Current weapons license
- \*Current QLD crowd controller / private investigator / security officer license
- \*Passbook / account statement- used in the six months
- \*Australian taxation assessment - dated in the last six months

The following proof of identification documentation is **no longer** accepted.

#### List 1

Passports that expired within the last 2 years Consular photo identity card

#### List 2

- \*Utility bills (telephone, gas, electricity)
- \*Rates notices / land valuations
- \*Electoral card / enrolment notice
