# GOLF PROGRAM

## GENERAL INFORMATION



The course aims to develop student's ability across all facets of golf and particular emphasis is not only placed on game play and increasing students overall golfing skill level, but importantly, golf etiquette and self responsibilities in the wider golf club environment. Students will participate in a wide variety of activities relating to the golf industry—video analysis, competitions, sports psychology and physiology.

The program has facilities not evident in other Queensland programs—purpose built golf green on site at school, a second pitching green, three target greens, a quality practise range, a green-side and fairway bunker, grass tee box, a 300 metre driving range and an indoor putting green.

The program accepts the participation of students from the International Student Program. Professional golfers, Amy Yang and Haeji Kang were some of our students and are currently members of the US Ladies Tour.

Students will play regularly at a number of quality golf courses, such as Lakelands, Royal Pines Resort, The Glades, The Colonial and Robina Woods. This will enable students to enhance their shot-making skills on a variety of courses.

Strong links have been formed with the Gold Coast Golf industry including Private courses, Resort courses, teaching academies and their various sources of expertise.

The course provides up-to-date software (eg. biomechanics study—Swinger Pro Software). The technology we have for enhancement includes a golf-specific laptop and a digital recording camera.

Six hours of time-tabled school hours are available for golf tuition, guest speakers, theory components, swing analysis and golf course play each week.

## ROBINA STATE HIGH SCHOOL GOLF OPPORTUNITIES



Opportunities will exist for elite level players to participate in various golf tournaments. It will be an expectation that participation in tournaments will be part of the program for elite players. The golf program participates in the Queensland Intercollegiate Golf Association competition (2006, 2007 and 2008 Girls Division One Winners), which involves a team of five boys and a team of three girls.

A requirement of the program is that students hold a membership of a Golf Club and have a current club handicap.

Robina State High School can supply quality equipment for practice at school including practice balls—Titleist Pro V1 and Bridgestone B330S Tour Balls.

## COACHING COORDINATORS



### SHANE STEVENSON

Shane has been an active golf player in Victoria, Sunshine Coast and Far North Queensland for over 25 years and is presently a member of the Gold Coast Burleigh Golf Club. Shane has been involved in Junior Pennants, District Golf Association Teams and Senior Pennants. He has also worked as the joint coordinator of a \$15000 Pro-Am tournament as part of the Queensland PGA 'Troppo' Tour.

Shane has been a teacher for 20 years, specializing in Physical Education and fitness components such as exercise science and training, and is a nationally accredited Golf Coach.

Mark Officer has been a PGA Member since 1986 during which time he was a tournament player, winning events on the Australian PGA Tour as well as in Asia and Europe. In 1997 he then specialised in teaching and is presently working with the Lakelands Golf Academy.
