HOW WILL IT BE DELIVERED?

Interested and motivated students who have a passion to learn more about our industry are invited to apply - we take a 'quality over quantity' approach. The program will be delivered at no cost to students via VETis (funded by DET's VET investment budget) and will have the following features:

- Successful applicants will be expected to attend site 1 day/week for all the school year, gain a white card do an induction, complete a Certificate I in Construction plus 80 hours of Structured Workplace Learning (SWL).
- On-line delivery of the underpinning knowledge based on a series of 'Tasks' which cluster common aspects of the required competencies and the use of a unique webcam based learning management system allows us greater diversity of assessment, student responses and validity of the training undertaken. Our Learning Management System has been designed and built by Hutchinson Builders Trainers using videos and photos from our sites.
- Practical training is on a construction site undertaking real construction activities
- Understanding the variety of careers available and effective job application skills will be a central part of our program.
- Coaching students on how to find and organise their own work placements so they have the skills to find their own employment once they are Ready 4 Construction.
- Students will be offered 80 hours of Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) with site teams or local subcontractors with at least a 1 week block to be completed in school holidays. Students choosing to complete 160 hours of SWL and a portfolio can achieve an extra 2 QCE points – this is delivered in partnership with CSQ.

Ready 4 Construction (R4C) for Year 12 students in 2019.

The Gold Coast School of Construction (GCSC) is owned and operated by Hutchinson Builders will be delivering a Certificate 1 in Construction program at the VUE TERRACE HOMES building site in Robina (opposite CBUS Stadium).



The VUE TERRACE HOMES project is a Hutchies site that commenced in March of this year and will run throughout 2019. Currently there are 300 workers onsite working across more than 20 trades. This is also only 1 of nearly 40 Hutchinson Builders job sites on the Gold Coast.



The Certificate 1 course includes 80 hours of work experience with 1 day a week on a live site undertaking real construction activities.

This opportunity will give students hands on site training. They will be doing work experience with onsite sub-contractors with potential to impress and secure either a school based apprenticeship or full time apprenticeship upon leaving school.

This is the perfect way for all students to identify their preferred career pathway in the construction industry and to perform and excel on a live site in front of sub-contractors looking to employ.

Employers in the construction industry are looking for keen young men & women who show interest in a trade, vitality in their work and a sound knowledge of tools, materials and safety.

Our Certificate 1 program will deliver hand & power tool training and also includes a White card with site induction and all relevant safety requirements to be competent onsite.



Insurance is covered by a Workplace Agreement signed by the contractor, the parent and the student and Gold Coast School of Construction. Some schools may choose to cover insurance themselves?

Our Learning Management system has been designed and built by Hutchinson Builders Trainers using videos, learning content and photos from our own sites.

This Online Delivery System is based on a series of tasks for the required competencies using our unique webcam based learning management system. This allows us greater diversity of assessment, student responses and validity of the training undertaken.

The Gold Coast School of Construction has played a major part in securing apprenticeships with Hutchinson Builders and many other sub-contractors due to having applicants job ready.

The Certificate 1 program will give students an understanding of the variety of careers available and the 33 different apprenticeships across the industry and develop the necessary skills required to apply for potential positions.
