- Played on LET while in Year 12 recording 4 top 20 finishes
- 2008 Ladies German Open winner – donated prize of \$60,000 to victims of recent earthquake in China
- 2008 Gained full playing status on LPGA for 2009
- 2013 LPGA KEB-HanaBank Championship (South Korea) winner
- 2015 Honda LPGA Championship (Thailand) winner
