STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

Robina State High School is a uniform school and all students are required to wear the complete school uniform each day. Students should be fresh, neat and tidy in their uniform at all times.

The school uniform supports our school priority of high expectations and creates a positive image of the school in our community.

It is a requirement that students will have both formal and sport uniforms, wearing them a minimum of two days (7-10) each per week. <u>In 2025 the allocated formal uniform days are Tuesday and Thursday.</u> Students are required to be in formal uniform on these days.

Some practical subjects e.g. Dance, Drama, Health Science may require students to change into relevant attire of their sport uniform for the allocated lesson. Teachers will inform parents directly of expected requirements.


Any student that has Sports Academy training in Period 0 classes must change out of their training kit into their formal uniform on a Tuesday and Thursday.

Students are required to wear their formal uniform for all formal occasions including school excursions, ceremonies and any other formal school or public functions.

Robina State High School uniforms are to be worn correctly, in their entirety, every day from leaving home until returning home from school.

Students must not:

- Mix and match their formal and sport uniform items
- Roll up their sleeves
- Roll over the waistband of their skirts or shorts
- Wear visible undershirts
- Fold over their socks
- Alter the hem line on any item

- All black leather polishable lace up shoes (as per images and description below)
- Minimum White quarter crew socks with no visible logo
- Robina SHS Hat (cap or bucket hat)
- Robina SHS Senior blue Sport polo
- Robina SHS Sport shorts (minimum mid-thigh length)
- Robina SHS Navy knit jumper
- Robina SHS jacket
- Robina SHS Tracksuit pant (only to be worn in winter with sport uniform)
- Hair ties white, black, navy, maroon





FOOTWEAR

Due to workplace Health and Safety regulations, students' footwear must provide adequate protection and cover the entire foot. Footwear selection must also take into account the health benefits of growing children wearing supportive footwear to minimise future health risks. Robina State High School maintains very strict footwear requirements.

- All-black, fully enclosed, polishable leather (no suede) lace-up shoes are to be worn with both
 the day and sports uniform. If students have sport specific shoes, they may bring these to
 school and change into them at the start of the sport lesson and must change back into their
 black leather shoes immediately after the sport lesson.
- No skate/roller shoes, slip-ons, high topcs, boots, coloured laces, ballet flats, high tops, canvas or suede shoes are permitted.

Students must wear a minimum quarter crew white sock. These must sit well above the ankle joint. No logo should be visible.



BAGS

All students should present with an appropriate backpack. Handbags or other types of bags are not permitted for workplace health and safety reasons.

HATS

Any student undertaking a sport, HPE or outdoor activity will be expected to wear a Robina State High School school hat. Similarly, students utilising the basketball courts or ovals during the two breaks will also be required to wear a school hat. When students are travelling to and from school or representing the school on excursions, only a Robina State High School hat is permitted to be worn. No alternative designs or hats will be





permitted at any tim and the hat must not be altered in any capacity.

HAIR

Hair should be cut and styled in a fashion that is suitable for a professional business workplace. Hair colour is to be of natural tones and no extreme styles including, tracks, or shaved sections or colours are permitted. Extreme mullet-style haircuts with shaved sides are not acceptable.

All hair that is longer than collar length is to be tied up off the shoulders at all times.

Hairbands, scrunchies and ribbons must be one of the school colours; white, black, navy or maroon. No patterned hairbands, including scrunchies are permitted.

Cultural or religious head pieces or hair wraps are permitted (e.g. turban, hijab, khimar).

JEWELLERY

- A watch and one ring are optional.
- One simple gold or silver chain, less than 8mm wide, with a pendent on it less than 20mm in length from end to end is permitted. Any other religious or cultural necklace must have written approval, which can be requested by application to the principal.
- If ears are pierced, they may be fitted with up to two earrings per ear with either studs or sleepers only. Studs are not to be greater than 5mm in diameter and sleepers are not be greater than 15mm in diameter (outer edge to outer edge). Earrings with dangly accessories, stretchers, spikes and threaders are not permitted.
- Any other visible face piercing must be completely removed for school or contain a clear stud.
- Bracelets are not permitted. Official medical bracelets are acceptable.
- Tattoos must not be visible.

MAKE UP

- Make-up, including mascara is not permitted.
- Coloured nail polish is not permitted.
- Acrylic or gel nails are not permitted.
- Sunscreen is encouraged in our climate at all times. It should be of natural skin tones or translucent.
